AMENDING THE PRIOR APPROVAL FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AUTHORIZED FOR A SPECIFIED PROJECT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITIES CORPORATION (Drinking Water State Revolving Fund)

WHEREAS, the New York State Public Authorities Control Board ("PACB"), created pursuant to Chapter 38, Laws of 1976, as amended, is empowered by section 51 of the Public Authorities Law to receive applications from designated public benefit corporations, including the Environmental Facilities Corporation ("EFC"), for approval of the acquisition, construction or financing of any project by any such public benefit corporation; and

WHEREAS, EFC submits from time to time applications to PACB for approval of short-term and long-term financings as authorized in an EFC resolution duly adopted by EFC's Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, PACB duly received an application from EFC for approval of financings from available funding through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund duly adopted by Resolution No. 2662 (the "EFC Resolution") at a meeting of EFC's Board of Directors held on June 27, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on July 31, 2019, PACB adopted Resolution No. 19-EF-778 (the "PACB Resolution"), approving the financings in the EFC Resolution, which included a \$2,334,560 short-term financing (the "Financing") to the City of Middletown (the "Recipient"); and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2863 adopted on October 14, 2021, the

EFC's Board of Directors authorized an amendment of the Financing to modify the scope of the Financing; and

WHEREAS, PACB approved the amendment to the Financing on October 20, 2021 through adoption of Resolution No. 21-EF-778A; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 3016 adopted on March 14, 2024, the EFC's Board of Directors authorized an amendment of the Financing to increase the amount of the Financing and extend the maturity date; and

WHEREAS, PACB approved the amendment to the Financing on March 20, 2024 through adoption of Resolution No. 24-EF-778B; and

WHEREAS, an extension of the Financing's maturity date is needed to ensure inclusion in the 2025 long-term leveraged pooled financing; and

WHEREAS, PACB has received an application (the "Application") from EFC seeking approval to amend the Financing authorized to the Recipient to provide for an extension of the Financing maturity date as authorized in an EFC resolution duly adopted at a meeting of EFC Board of Directors held on October 10, 2024; and

WHEREAS, this amendment of the PACB Resolution is specific to the Financing authorized to the Recipient and all other authorizations, determinations, terms and conditions contained in the PACB Resolution and subsequent amendments to said resolution shall remain in effect; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the Application has been filed with the

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Comptroller, and he has had the opportunity to comment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that PACB approves extension of the Financing's maturity date from February 1, 2025 to May 31, 2025, in accordance with section 51 of the Public Authorities Law:

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This resolution shall become effective immediately.

Project Description

This project consists of the construction of a new 2 million-gallon (MG) water storage tank at Mountain Avenue; construction of a new 0.75 MG water storage tank at the High Barney site; rehabilitation of the 0.5 MG welded steel tank at Highland Avenue; and the possible inclusion of a mixing system at the Mountain Avenue and High Barney tanks.

The project is defined by the engineering report entitled "Proposed Water Storage Tanks at Mountain Avenue, and at Water Treatment Facility" dated December 2015 by the engineering firm Clark Patterson Lee, Design Professionals, and by the amended engineering report entitled "Proposed Revisions to Project Scope - City of Middletown New Water Storage Tanks" dated June 11, 2020, as may be updated, amended, supplemented, and approved by the New York State Department of Health.
