# 24-DA-1390

Issuance of multiple series of tax-exempt and/or taxable, fixed and/or variable rate bonds issued at one or more times in an amount not to exceed **\$2,500,000,000** under the **Sales Tax Revenue Bond Program and/or Personal Income Tax Revenue Bond Program** to finance or reimburse capital projects for the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets; the City University of New York; New York State's Downtown Revitalization Initiative; the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services; the Division of Military and Naval Affairs; the New York Power Authority energy project loan refinancings; the Office of Children and Family Services; the Office of General Services; the Olympic Regional Development Authority; the Department of State Police; the State University of New York (SUNY); and SUNY community colleges. Bonds are to be sold on either a competitive or negotiated basis. Final maturity will not exceed 30 years for the new money bonds. The refunding plan includes refunding certain bonds issued under various State supported debt programs.
