AN ACT

to amend chapter 60 of the laws of
2006, in relation to providing for
the administration of certain funds
and accounts related to the
2006-2007 budget; in relation to
authorizing certain payments and
transfers

The People of the State of New
York, represented in Senate and
Assembly, do enact as follows:

1) Single House Bill (introduced and printed separately in either or both
houses). Uni-Bill (introduced simultaneously in both houses and printed as one
bill. Senate and Assembly introducer sign the same copy of the bill).

2) Circle names of co-sponsors and return to introduction clerk with 2 signed
copies of bill and 4 copies of memorandum in support (single house); or 4 signed
copies of bill and 8 copies of memorandum in support (uni-bill).

1 Section 1. Subdivision 5 entitled Transportation in section 3 of chap-
2 ter 60 of the laws of 2006, in relation to authorizing certain payments,
3 deposits and transfers in support of government, is amended to read as
4 follows:

5 § 3. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, and in accordance with
6 section 4 of the state finance law, the comptroller is hereby authorized
7 and directed to transfer, upon request of the director of the budget, on
8 or before March 31, 2007, up to the unencumbered balance or the follow-
9 ing amounts:

10 Transportation:

11 5. [~~\$23,000,000~~] \$29,000,000 from the general fund to the public tran-
12 sit operating assistance fund (313.01).

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be deemed to
14 have been in full force and effect on and after April 1, 2006.
