**Amendments to Senate 57; Assembly 157  
(Education, Labor, and Family Assistance Article VII Bill)**

**Part A**, relating to the implementation of the 2009-10 Executive Budget School Aid proposal is amended to:

- Delete amendments relating to comprehensive attendance taking (CAP) requirements for nonpublic schools (Sections 10-a and 10-b), thereby maintaining existing requirements.
- Clarify the proposal to recover Building Aid from school districts due to the sale or transfer of a building by specifying that school districts must report such sales to the Commissioner of Education.
- Establish a demonstration program in Syracuse that would provide for scholarships at public colleges and universities to students in the Syracuse City School district that meet certain eligibility criteria.
- Make technical corrections.

**Part G**, relating to indemnity for city and state university students is amended to:

- Extend Executive Budget proposal indemnifying State University of New York students enrolled in clinical coursework to include students at City University of New York senior colleges.

**Part H**, relating to tuition assistance program awards for eligible students is amended to:

- Make technical corrections.

**Part J**, relating to the establishment of a program to provide loans to students to finance the costs of post-secondary education is amended to:

- Make several technical corrections related to program structure and related bond underwriting provisions.
