A BUDGET BILL submitted by the Governor in accordance with Article VII of the Constitution

AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to providing a rent cap for people living with HIV/AIDS in social services districts with a population over five million

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 131-a of the social services law is amended by
- 2 adding a new subdivision 14 to read as follows:
- 3 14. In determining the need for aid provided pursuant to public
- 4 assistance programs, each person living with clinical/symptomatic HIV
- 5 illness or AIDS in social services districts with a population over five
- 6 million who is receiving services through such district's administrative
- 7 unit providing HIV/AIDS services, public assistance and earned and/or
- 8 unearned income, shall not be required to pay more than thirty percent
- 9 of his or her monthly earned and/or unearned income toward the cost of
- 10 rent that such person has a direct obligation to pay; this provision
- 11 shall not apply to room and board arrangements.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided that no funds
- 13 shall be expended pursuant to this act until a plan submitted by a
- 14 district has been approved by the office of temporary and disability
- 15 assistance and the director of the budget.
