FY 2023 Executive Budget Amendments

Amendments to Senate S.8006; Assembly A.9006 (ELFA Article VII Bill)

Part A, relating to implementation of the 2022-23 Executive Budget School Aid proposal, is amended to:

• Clarify that the form in which transportation contracts must be submitted to the State Education Department also includes an "electronic form approved by the commissioner when available" as a permissible submission.

Part L, relating to child care, is amended to:

• Make a technical correction for the effective date.

Part U, relating to the public benefits and requirements, is amended to:

• Make a technical amendment to ensure that the June 2022 obligation is removed, as intended, consistent with other changes to the public assistance program in this legislation.

Part AA, relating to the permit to create accessory dwelling units, is amended to:

• Removes the statewide requirement to provide for the creation of accessory dwelling units (ADUs), focusing instead on an authorization for New York City to establish a program to legalize pre-existing ADUs, including providing for amnesty.

Part EE, relating to transit oriented development, is amended to:

• Intentionally omit the part.

Part II, relating to the enactment of the Affordable Neighborhoods for New Yorkers Tax Incentive, is amended to:

 Make technical amendments to clarify the original intention of the bill.
